I Spent most of my career on the streets serving the public of Surrey.

Spent 6 years working in the Officer Safety Unit delivering the full training programme covering all the skills required by the current officer safety programme. Taking the role of lead trainer in a number of disciplines, including, CBRN, Special Constable Officer Safety Training and Student Constable Officer Safety Training.

I then moved to a firearms role where I spent the remainder of my service.

Working as part of a four-officer unit, in Armed Response Vehicles covering the county of Surrey, not only responding to Armed incidents but also in the use of Taser and Baton guns for other incidents where normal patrol officers are at risk from violent suspects.

Train Firearms / Patrol officers in CBRN (NBC) drills including CS Chamber drills, Identification and initial action to a suspect CBRN event.

Lecture on CBRN actions to student constables, Bronze and Silver Commanders.

Conducted tabletop exercises for both initial response officers and Commanders during a Major Incident

Conduct Multi Agency Command Training dealing with CBRN Incidents.

Responsible for the delivery of the Hostile situations Training programme,

training, handcuff, baton and breakaway skills. Delivery of specialist training as required by the company.

I became their lead Instructor, and continue to train officers in Baton, Cuff, and open hand skills, delivering this training to SAFFA enforcement officers from the Environment Agency, who have the full powers of a constable whilst out on patrol, as such they carry Batons and Handcuffs so require training to the same standard as Police Officers. As the lead trainer it is my responsibility to ensure the training is current and relevant using the current College of Policing Guidelines.

Surrey Police

I re-joined Surrey Police as a Civilian Personal Safety Trainer, delivering the full programme to all departments of the force.

I have been involved in running the new strands of Police Recruit Training as well as refresher training to both operational and non-operational staff.

My lead instructor portfolio is currently carrying out all the Custody training from Initial detention officers and Sgt's and all refreshers.
